The Model WPH-FTK is a turnkey, ruggedized, self-contained, battery powered, man-portable patient tracking system. It includes a Wi-Fi HotSpot with 3G Internet access, a quad battery charger for the handhelds and a fully automatic battery/charger system that will power all equipment for up to 8 hours on battery and indefinitely on AC or vehicle power.

The WPH-FTK is ready to operate, anywhere, anytime because the design allows all hardware and software to be fully connected and configured.

The package provides for storage/operation of a laptop and up to 4 handhelds. There is also room for documents, cables and other small items. All major components are industry standard and user serviceable.

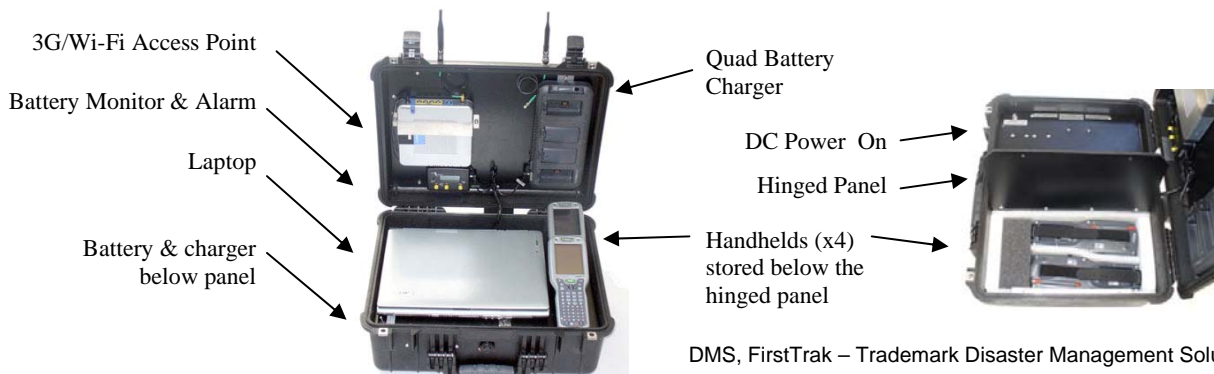
